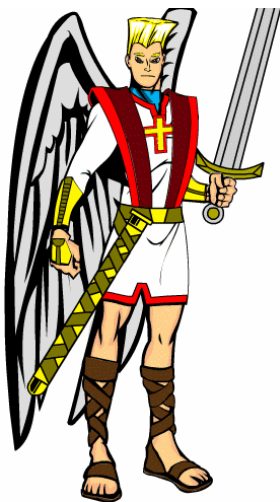


**Chesterfield Parish Church
