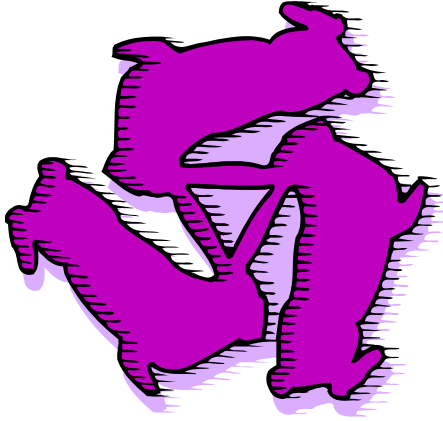

Trinity Sunday (7th June 2020)

FROM TODAY, MASSES WILL LARGELY REVERT TO 'NORMAL' TIMES

ALL MASSES WILL CONTINUED TO BE STREAMED LIVE, WILL REMAIN ON FACEBOOK AND WILL BE UPLOADED TO YOUTUBE.

EVENING PRAYER WILL BE STREAMED AT 4.00 TODAY, AND WILL NOT BE STREAMED THEREAFTER.

This is necessary not just for the sake of 'normality' but also to give back to the clergy the flexibility to use time effectively now that demands and duties are arising (thick and fast) outside the home.

Streaming of Masses will continue at least until Masses with a congregation are permitted (and can be done with an acceptable level of safety), and probably for some time after that.

IF THERE IS A RETURN TO LOCKDOWN CONDITIONS, THEN IT IS LIKELY THAT THE SCHEDULE WILL CHANGE AGAIN TO SUIT.

Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them. When they saw him, they worshipped him; but some doubted.
