Confident Faith

Today's scripture readings speak of confidence in God. Jesus tells his followers to trust; Stephen commends his spirit into God's hands.

So often we are inclined to think that God's work in the Church depends on us, yet the growth of the early Church came from a faith and trust in God, and a confidence that God would bring the best from all that we do.

We—both here and in the wider Church—need to be reminded that we are doing God's work, and that it is God who will bring the fruit from the labour of our hands.

And I think that is something to take from the Coronation liturgy too—the King has God's work to do, and the fruit of his labour will be a gift from God.

Today we can ask for a confident faith that God will bring about among us the promised future, and also that we may learn to trust in God, who knows everything that we need.

Please respect those who wish to prepare for Mass in quiet prayer; also those who wish to listen to the closing Organ Voluntary.
